# Exceptions and Waivers

- **Due by November 1, 2016**
- A district or charter school that does not have the appropriately certified teachers to serve LEP students in accordance with Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §89.1205 must apply to Texas Education Agency (TEA) for a bilingual exception and/or ESL waiver.
- This application must be made each year there is a need for an exception and/or waiver.
- Must be submitted in an email directly from the superintendent.
