This 10-week project-based learning opportunity includes 8 weeks of service learning, in which participants work in pairs to address the skill deficits of local children with autism and other developmental disabilities. Ongoing didactic instruction focuses on behavior-analytic approaches to strengthening verbal behavior through:

- Functionally analyzing verbal behavior
- Identifying the verbal operants
- Verbal behavior assessment

  - Assessment of Basic Language and Learning Skills - Revised (ABLLS-R)
  - Essentials for Living (EFL)
  - Stimulus Control Ratio Equation (SCoRE)
- Transferring stimulus control
- Errorless learning
- Precision Teaching
- Derived stimulus relations
- Operationally defining behavior
- Observing and recording behavior
- Developing individualized treatment plans
- Progress monitoring
- Data-based decision making
