

# **TEKS Update-Clarification Document AIS-Instructional Services Zaragoza**

Welcome to the TEKS Resource System, TEKS Clarification document video. I've already logged in. And I'm going to go over to my Quick Search area. And I'm going to choose Grade 5, Mathematics, and hit Search.

So clarification documents are documents generally they either are the first or the second component of the content area and subject that you have gone into the system in. And for Math, it'll be the second one.

So Math is a little special. Their's is actually, as you can see here, an enhanced TEKS Clarification document. For all of our Math courses, kindergarten through high school, the enhanced TEKS Clarification document is one grade level, all of the standards, in chronological order.

As I scroll down past the narrative, the introduction paragraph, as well as my process standards in Math, and I get to my first content standards-- this is fifth grade, so I'll go to 5.2. And as you scroll down, you'll start seeing examples, and charts, and tables, and multiple representations for each of the student expectations as notated in the student expectation.

So the important thing as Math teachers to remember is that these examples, and charts, and tables, and multiple representations are at TEA's expectation. So it's a great resource to reconcile your instruction in your classroom to make sure that you are showing them multiple representations. As the State says, these are the examples of different charts, different tables, different graphs.

So Clarification documents in Math, and Math only, as you take time to scroll through and peruse your Enhanced TEKS Clarification document, you'll see this resource is a huge help in making sure that your students get to see skill and content at the depth of TEA's expectation.

So Clarification documents are not in every single grade level or course. Clarification documents are generally part of the system if you don't have a Vertical Alignment document. So Clarification documents, in Math, we have them kindergarten all the way through all of the high school Math courses. They are all enhanced with the examples that I've just said.

We also have all of the Science courses at high school. They are not included in a Vertical Alignment document. So science, high school only has Clarification documents. And then, Social Studies also has Clarification documents from kindergarten all the way through high school courses.
