Education Service Center, Region 20 is excited to offer principals, assistant principals and other campus leaders an opportunity to collaborate with a diverse group of outstanding educational leaders who are committed to improving their practice and leading change in their communities.

ESC-20 Network participants have the opportunities to:

- Attend ten monthly 3.5 hour meetings. Meetings will occur during the evening at a local restaurant in San Antonio. (Meals are included).
- Collaborate with diverse leaders from throughout the region.
- Accelerate campus changes leading to student achievement through a structure of collegial support.
- Develop protocols and leadership skills to promote a feedback-rich, growth-minded school culture.
- Engage leaders and support colleagues through strategic planning as they enhance their leadership.
- Build their instructional leadership expertise through peer dialogue, real time problem-solving, and infusion of resources.

The ESC-20 Network members will gain a deeper understanding of the *Texas Principal Standards* and how they apply to the day-to-day role of a campus leader. Through discussion protocols and an investigation of Balanced Leadership Responsibilities, participants will collaboratively explore various problems of practice to gain insight and refine practices.
